Membership Category Explanations

Ordinary

An ordinary member shall be the owner of a registered stud and must own at least five Speckle Park animals. Ordinary membership is principally intended for members wishing to register purebred speckle park cattle. Ordinary members must be over 18 and are allocated 1 vote per ordinary membership. Members must submit a stud prefix and herd ID when applying for ordinary membership.

Associate

An associate member shall be the owner of a registered stud and must own at least one (and no more than four) Speckle Park animals. Associate membership is principally intended for members wishing to register purebred speckle park cattle. Associate members must be over 18 and are not entitled to vote at any general meetings. Members must submit a stud prefix and herd ID when applying for associate membership.

Commercial

A commercial member shall be a person with a special interest in Speckle Park cattle and are breeding or producing cattle for marketing through a commercial operation but do not intend to register stud animals. Commercial members must be over 18 and are not entitled to vote at any general meetings.

Junior

Junior members must be 18 years and under. Junior members are entitled to register Speckle Park progeny however are not entitled to vote at any general meetings. A stud prefix and herd ID should be included on the application for Junior membership.

International

Any member located outside of Australia shall be classed as an International member. Ordinary, Associate, Commercial and Junior International memberships are available with the above explanations applying to the respective membership categories. International members are not required to pay GST.

Stud Prefix

Ordinary, Associate and Junior memberships require a stud prefix not exceeding 16 characters. This prefix shall be used as your stud name and as part of the name of every animal which you as the breeder submit for registration. The words "Speckle Park" are not permitted to be used in your stud prefix.

Herd ID

A herd ID is a combination of 3 alpha characters or alpha numeric characters. Each member is issued a unique Herd ID which is used in the ident of all animals which are registered under your stud name. An example of an animals ID:

Herd ID → BBB X1 ← ID number
 ↑
 Year letter

Your herd ID is used for all correspondence with the society such as payments, emails, calf registrations etc.
