FOOT AND MOUTH DISEASE



Foot and mouth disease (FMD) is a very contagious viral disease that affects cattle, sheep, goats and pigs with significant and detrimental impacts for animal health and industry. On 5 July 2022, the Indonesian Government confirmed an outbreak of FMD in livestock in Bali.

The Australian Government has increased its border protection measures to prevent the spread to Australia however, as members of the cattle industry, it is important we are aware of what to look for. Signs include:

- fever, drooling and reluctance to move in cattle, pigs, sheep, buffalo, deer, camelids and goats; and
- blisters on the mouth, snout, tongue, lips or between and above the hooves; blisters may be intact or ruptured, exposing raw, painful tissue.

If livestock exhibit any signs consistent with FMD, it must be immediately reported to a local veterinarian or the Emergency Animal Disease Watch Hotline on 1800 675 888. Early detection and reporting will provide the best change of Australia being able to contain and eradicate FMD.

As a not for profit organisation, developing mutually beneficial relationships with like-minded parties is critically important for the advancement of SPI. Together with the Board, the Marketing and Events Sub-Committee have commenced preparing the SPI Sponsorship Packages for 22/33.

Opportunities will include 2022/23 Sponsorship Packages as well as Supporter Packages specific to the Sydney Royal Easter Show Feature Breed program.

As we work to grow both SPI and the Speckle Park breed, we welcome your input and assistance in connecting us with potential partners. If you are interested in partnering with SPI or know of an organisation that shares consistent purpose and vision to SPI, please get in contact with the Marketing and Events Sub-Committee to discuss further.


